Our view of Life in the Missionary Key is the fundamental perspective in its orientation "to proclaiming the Gospel of the Good News in and through our gathering at each level of ecclesial life through listening, dialogue, community discernment and creation of consensus as an expression that renders Christ present in the Holy Spirit, each taking decisions with their responsibilities".

The essence of Synodality is the seeds of the Gospel of Jesus, that each baptised as constitutive part of the People of God takes responsibility to care for the nursery to nurture the seeds to grow into plants that will bear fruit. It is these grains of wheat and rice that will become the Bread of Life and Food of Life for the Humanity awaiting to be fed with life-giving abundance of joy of sharing God's gifts.


